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We are over the moon excited about our latest addition to the Three Sticks lineup, our 2018 Cuvée Alana Pinot Noir. Planted in 2010 and named after Bill Price's youngest daughter, the Alana Vineyard sits on a steep hillside amongst the redwoods in the cool Green Valley appellation just outside the town of Occidental. This pinot haven is close to the Pacific Ocean and feels the impact of the afternoon fog that rolls in early in the day. This cooling effect slows down the development of sugars and acid, making sure the grapes mature at a slow and steady rate. Super limited in production, this wine is intoxicating with aromas of apple blossoms, black cherry and all-spice with bursts of bright acidity. The mid-palate has notes of Santa Rosa plum galette which lead to a finish of super silky tannins. We are obsessed.

We believe in stewardship of the land, the vineyards, and the people. We are for real connections, real history, real wines; experiences you will never forget. We welcome you to our home, the Adobe, for an historic tasting in Sonoma.
